  - Charlie Keaney made a motion to upgrade a Grade 9 referee to Grade 8 will be the fee to recertify a Grade 8 referee, Tre Gaither second. Motion passed.
  - Charlie Keaney made a proposal to maintain new Grade 8 referee fees at \$70, James Ferguson. Motion approved.
- > Charlie Keaney will pursue feedback from the administrator and instructors on re-instituting a Grade 9 in Ohio South.
